## Children Can't Wait:

A roundtable discussion on the special needs of children with neurodevelopmental disabilities (ND) in times of conflict. The discussion will be held as part of the **48**<sup>th</sup> **MEMA: First Global Conflict Medicine Congress.** May 11-14, 2017 at the American University of Beirut, Lebanon.

#### **Background and Mission Statement:**

As war and conflict become a way of life for millions of children in our region (Middle East and North Africa), we seek to highlight the special needs of children with neurodevelopment disabilities (ND) (including physical, mental and intellectual). During war and conflict, these already vulnerable children are further compromised by physical injury, disease, violence, displacement and the loss of appropriate interventions services.

#### Focus:

We aim to provide an inclusive multidisciplinary forum for all stakeholders to share their experience and to promote collaboration in this neglected field. Stakeholders include healthcare workers, educators, researchers, community advocates, social workers, government ministries, local and international organizations, policy makers and other interested parties.

#### Specific Focus Topics:

- 1. Understanding the situation on the ground:
  - a. Who is affected? What is being provided to them? Who is doing what?
  - b. Existing policies and guidelines (successes and gaps).
  - c. Individual experiences with children with ND in the conflict setting
  - d. Research findings (past and ongoing)
- 2. Looking towards the future:
  - a. Practical steps for implementation of interventions
  - b. Research questions and how they can be addressed
  - c. Imagining the post-conflict future (and how do we prepare our children for it).
- 3. Other topics related to the mission of the roundtable
